CMA Secures \$50 Million Contract with Capral Aluminium Australia

CMA Corporation (ASX: CMV) is pleased to announce that it has secured a major new contract with Capral Aluminium Limited (ASX: CAA) valued at more than \$50 million.

The two year agreement with CMA Recycling is for the collection and recycling of approximately 16,000 tonnes of non ferrous metal, 1,000 tonnes of ferrous metal and small amounts of mixed metals.

Capral is a major supplier of aluminium extrusion and sheet products with an extensive network of warehousing operations, service centres and manufacturing plants across Australia.

CMA Managing Director Doug Rowe said he was delighted to have secured the Capral contract.

“The quality of CMA’s service offering has again been demonstrated by this significant contract win,” said Mr Rowe.

“With purpose built bins and specialist equipment we are able to handle Capral’s requirements on a national level with professionalism and efficiency.”

Mr Rowe also confirmed the importance of CMA’s relationship with Capral.

“Having served a number of Capral’s individual sites for many years, it is pleasing to now be contracted for its national operations and have the opportunity to add the entire group to our valued client base,” he said.

“We expect this contract to make a significant contribution to CMA Recycling and the overall group.”

The CMA Recycling division recycled and sold more than 420,000 tonnes of ferrous and non-ferrous metals in the 6 months to 31 December 2007.

Mr Rowe said the company was on track for a strong second half of the 2008 financial year.

The agreement with Capral is expected to commence in April 2008.
