## **CMA Announces \$45 Million Contract with GM Holden**

CMA Corporation (ASX: CMV) is pleased to announce that it has been awarded a contract with GM Holden Australia valued at \$45 million.

The contract is for the collection and recycling of scrap metal from Holden's operations in South Australia and Victoria.

The contract will increase the CMA Recycling division's intake of ferrous metals by more than 70,000 tonnes per year and non ferrous metals by approximately 1,500 tonnes per year.

In addition, the zinc coated material collected from Holden's operations will provide feed for CMA's Meretec de-zincing plant in Ringwood, Victoria.

CMA Managing Director Doug Rowe said securing a contract with a group such as GM Holden was a major achievement for the CMA Recycling division.

"CMA's ability to provide a total collection and recycling package was key to securing this contract with GM Holden," said Mr Rowe.

"Our improved handling methods and innovative processing practices will deliver solid savings and efficiencies to the company."

Mr Rowe added that he was confident of CMA's ability to acquire further business in the automotive industry, a key market for the Recycling division.

"Having a client of the calibre of GM Holden on board proves our ability to secure and service major clients," he said

"This contract represents yet another significant milestone for us and further reinforces CMA as an emerging force in responsible recycling."

"We look forward to a long and successful business relationship with GM Holden both in Australia and abroad."

The GM Holden agreement commences on 26 March 2008.
