## **CMA Increases Holding in Malaysian Operations**

CMA Corporation Limited (ASX: CMV) is pleased to announce that it has increased its holding in the Malaysian based metal processing company Purata Keuntungan Sdn Bhd ("Purata") to 100% ownership.

Purata was established in September 2007 as a joint venture in which CMA held a 40% stake. The company's core operations are the processing and sale of steel mill residues.

CMA Managing Director Doug Rowe said that the business offers solid potential for future growth and is expected to contribute positively to the group result for the 2008 financial year.

"Full ownership of Purata will enable CMA to further increase the efficiency of operations and have a higher level of responsiveness to buyers and suppliers."

CMA has paid a total of A\$3 million in cash to acquire the 60% of Purata it did not already own.

Under the terms of the acquisition, CMA will also pay a fee to the former joint venture partners for the handling and tolling of the material running through the processing plant.

"Increasing CMA's stake in Purata enables the group to control the running of the business and improve the efficiency in the supply and delivery chains," said Mr Rowe.

"The Malaysian plant is currently capable of processing up to 3,000 tonnes per day and there is a high volume of input readily available.

"The Purata business has a very strong fit with CMA's strategy of using processing to add value to stock and deliver positive shareholder returns."
